A UKLA Steering Committee meeting was held on the 10th November 2011 in York. The group discussed ways to promote the UKLA in 2012, including ways to extend the business and technical model for UKLA members. Minutes will shortly be made available on the UKLA website.

The UK LOCKSS Alliance initiative was presented to the JARVIG committee on the 19th October 2011. JARVIG is defining a national implementation strategy for e-journal archiving in the UK. An action plan is now in development.

## System Development

Integration of LOCKSS with Ex Libris' SFX and Serials Solutions' 360Link is nearing completion. Test integrations have succeeded with both and we're making sure article level linking works before general release.

Development staff at EDINA have added functionality to LOCKSS to export holdings in KBART format. Look at the UKLA website for further guidance.

We are now turning our attention towards the LOCKSS User Interface, beginning by collecting together all user requirements expressed to date. More information will be circulated in a future announcement.
