- **So far.....**

- 17,500 AUs selected
- 3 library assistants LOCKSS trained
- LOCKSS firmly embedded in our efirst policy
- 2012 first year of major shift to efirst collection for current journals
- 900 print titles cancelled so far, more planned for 2013

# Case study: The LSE

- **May 2012, to do....**
  - Integrate LOCKSS with our Link resolver
  - Understanding when we need to panic!
  - Tidy up the journal configuration

# Case study: LSE

- **May 2011, to do....**
  - Integrate our LOCKSS box with our link resolver
  - Automate serving content and simulate a trigger event
  - Make qualitative and detailed quantitative statements about the extent of our LOCKSS content (PEPRS)
  - Preserve more than ejournals
